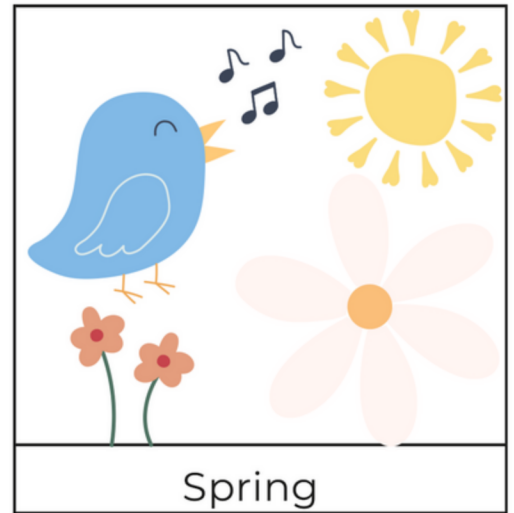

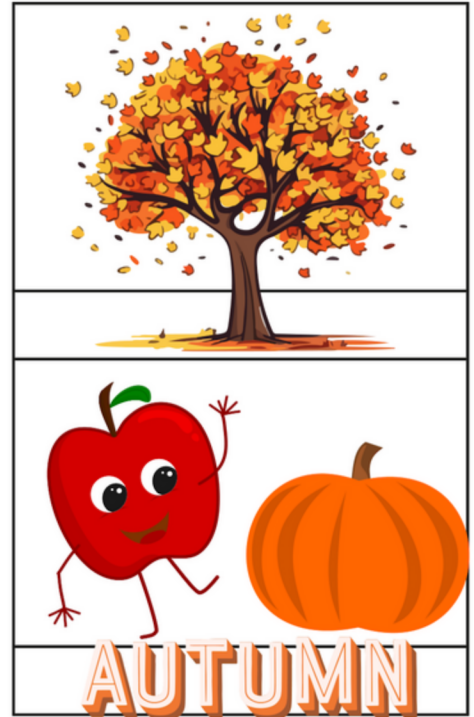
Autumn's Colors
